

CSRC Regatta - Conditions of Entry
Entry closing date is 8pm on Friday 3rd MAY!!

1. The regatta will take place at Castle Semple Loch, Lochwinnoch on Saturday 11th May 2024. The closing date for entries is 8pm on Friday 3rd of May.

2. All races will be rowed in accordance with Scottish Rowing rules.

3. All competitors must hold a valid **Racing Licence**. The licence must be valid at date of entry and on the date of the event. Your licence will be checked before any prize is given.

4. **Entry fees** are £11 for seniors and £9 for juniors. Coxes are free. (These fees include the Scottish Rowing levy).

5. Entries must be made using the **CSRC Entry Form**

ENTRIES CLOSE: 8pm on Friday 03rd May 2024. Late entries WILL NOT be accepted.

7. Payment should be made by Cheque (payable to "CSRC" Please mark clearly with your club name) or by BACS (Please email for account details).

8. The draw will take place on Saturday May 04th to Sunday May 05th 2024

Please provide a contact phone number where we are able to contact you over that weekend while the draw is taking place. The provisional draw will be emailed to Club Secretaries as soon as possible following the draw. The final draw will be available no later than Wednesday 8th May 2023.

9. The committee reserves the right to not run events with 2 entries or less. The entry contact will be notified in this case and where possible alternative events will be found.

10. The Committee aim to run single category **masters events** where practical. Failing that, races will be constructed with a **maximum 3 adjacent categories**

spread. These events will be run according to the Scottish Rowing handicapping system and the standard handicapping tables will be used.

11. Events have been split into sessions. Competitors may only enter 1 event per session. We will not consider coxes in regard to clashes.

12. It is the entering clubs' responsibility to ensure they have **sufficient boats** to support their entry and that all boats they use at the regatta comply with the **buoyancy clause** now incorporated within the Water Safety Code adopted by Scottish Rowing

14. Coxes **must** wear a lifejacket.

15. Competitors **must** adhere to the circulation pattern (issued with the draw).
