- 1. The regatta will take place at Castle Semple Loch, Lochwinnoch on Saturday 14th May 2016. The closing date is 9pm on Thursday 5th of May.
- 2. All races will be rowed in accordance with Scottish Rowing rules.
- 3. All races will be 1000m except where specified in the "list of events". The course is straight, multi-laned and fully buoyed.
- 4. All competitors must hold a valid **Racing Licence**. The licence must be valid at date of entry and on the date of the event. Your licence will be checked before any prize is given.
- 5. **Entry fees** are £8.00 for seniors, £6 for juniors, coxes are free (this includes the Scottish Rowing levy).
- 6. Entries can be posted or emailed using our digital entry form. It is important that an Entry Cover sheet is completed for every club's entry. Cheques must accompany a postal entry or follow an email entry.

- 8. Cheques should be made payable to "CSRC" (Please one cheque per club). BACS payments are also acceptable Please email for account details.
- 9. The draw will take place on Friday May 6th to Sunday May 8th 2016. Please provide a contact phone number where we are able to contact you over that weekend while the draw is taking place. The draw will be available not later than Wednesday 11th May 2016.

- 10. The committee reserves the right to not run events with 2 entries or less. The entry contact will be notified in this case and where possible alternative will be found.
- 11. The Committee aim to run single category **veteran events** where practical. Failing that, races will be constructed within a **maximum of 3 adjacent category spread**. These events will be run according to the Scottish Rowing handicapping system and the standard handicapping tables will be used.
- 12. We accept double entries. **Three or more entries will be accepted but with no guarantee of a rest period**. The 3rd choice for competitors should be marked clearly on the entry form.
- 13. All multiple entries must be clearly marked on the competitor list form. The organising committee will take no responsibility for time clashes where clashes have not been clearly indicated. Clashes for coxes will not be considered during the draw.
- 14. It is the entering clubs' responsibility to ensure they have **sufficient boats** to support their entry and that all boats they use at the regatta comply with the **buoyancy clause** now incorporated within the Water Safety Code adopted by Scottish Rowing
- 15. Coxes **must** wear a lifejacket.
- 16. Competitors **must** adhere to the circulation pattern (issued with the draw).
